Dear Parents / Guardians,

I would like to welcome your child to third class in St. Mark's Senior School.

The school reopens on Wednesday 1st September at 10.00 am. for all 3rd Class children.

Your child is to come to the School Hall at 10.00 a.m. They will then be divided into their classes and collected from the Hall by their teacher.

The school will be open for a full day and the children will go home at 2.30 p.m.

We are starting a new School Year and in order to ensure the smooth running of the school I would like to bring the following points to your attention.

1. School Opening

School Doors open at 8.50 a.m. and classes begin at 9.10 a.m., please ensure your child is in school by 9.10 a.m.

2. Collecting children early.

We appreciate that children do have to leave school early for Dental Appointments, Doctor's Appointments etc. but we would ask that these be kept to a minimum. If you do have to collect your child early, please send a note to your child's teacher.

3. Absences

If a child is absent from school for any reason, you must send a note to the class teacher explaining the reason for the absence. There is no need to telephone the school.

4. Book Rental & Materials Money

Many thanks to all of you who have paid the Book Rental and Materials Money. If you have not yet paid, you may pay when your child returns to school. If you wish to pay before that, the School Office will be open from Monday 23rd August to Friday 27th August from 9.30 a.m. to 12.00 noon each day.

5. School Books

You have received your child's book list, please ensure your child has all their books when they return to school in September. If you have misplaced the book list they are available on the School web site.

6. School Journal

Each child is required to have a School Journal. They will be available to purchase in the school at a cost of €4.

7. School Uniform

All children are required to wear the full school uniform to school each day except on P.E. day when they are requested to wear their St Mark's School Tracksuit.

8. Recorders

Children in some classes may be asked in September to purchase recorders, they will be available in the School Copy Shop which will open each morning from 8.50 a.m. to 9.10 a.m.

9. Swimming

Swimming is part of the P.E. Programme in the school. The children will walk to Tallaght Leisure Centre. You will be asked to pay for this in September.

10. Insurance

Brennan Insurance operate an insurance scheme for children. You will receive information and a form for this in early September. Should you wish to join the scheme the closing date will be 30th September 2010.
