The St. Mark's School Uniform consists of the following:

Pullover:	Navy Blue V-Necked with St. Mark's S.N.S. Embroidered Crest.
Shirt:	Blue.
Tie:	Navy with Blue and Red Bars.
Trousers:	Mid Grey
Skirts:	Mid Grey
Footwear:	Black / Brown leather shoes.

The St. Mark's School Track suit consists of the following.

St. Mark's School Track Suit Top (Embroidered Crest) must be worn on P.E. Day.

Plain blue brushed cotton bottoms (No logos)

A Blue Polo Shirt must be worn.

Footwear: Runners (astroturf shoes must not be worn as they cause damage to our lovely new floors.)

Please Note: Football Jerseys, Fashion tops or any other top is unacceptable with the track suit.

All children are expected to wear the School Uniform every day except P.E. Day when they will wear the St. Mark's Senior School Track suit.
